### **Police Federation Annual Conference 2010: Media Accreditation**

The Police Federation's annual conference takes place this year at the Bournemouth International Centre (BIC), from the afternoon of Monday 17th to lunchtime on Thursday 20th May, 2010.

This year's topics include:

- Olympics games in 2012 - are we ready?
- A critical look at the policing of public order events – are we meeting public expectation?
- It is likely we will have a new Home Secretary in May making the Federation conference one of the first diary appointments – a great opportunity to hear their vision for the future
- Conference will be asked to consider the implications of the current government policy of 'more for less' – are amalgamations the way forward?
- There will also be sessions on trauma risk management, disability and the implications of having a burgeoning female workforce on shift resilience
