Membership Costs

Officers from the Federated ranks can opt to become a subscribing member of the Federation, entitling them to the full range of support and assistance in accordance with Federation rules.

From 1st October 2022, membership costs £24.31 per month which is claimable against your income tax - the rebate makes the net cost of subscriptions under £20 a month.

In the first year as a student constable, this subscription is discounted by 50 per cent to £12.16 and then full subscriptions are then paid from the second year.
