1. Policy statement

PFEW believes that the special constabulary are designed to support their regular police colleagues and are not there to replace them.

2. Responsibility

The INB is responsible for all policy formation.

3. Summary

PFEW believes that the special constabulary, with paid sworn officers contributing a minimum contribution of four hours a week, has the potential to become an established police auxiliary that is police trained, attired and accountable.

PFEW agrees that serving members of the Special Constabulary should be allowed to become members of the Police Federation of England & Wales. In order to access the full range of membership services, members of the Special Constabulary will be required to pay the same rate of subscription to the voluntary fund as serving officers.

4. Procedures/implementation


We will establish a Special Constabulary working group.
